Yes, we can return to our school next week, and we will open on

But we have to keep everyone safe by following the rules of:

- Keeping a safe distance
- Following hygiene practices
- Year 4 - 6 children will need to bring & wear a mask

To do this we need to change the way school works.

We will work in bubbles in classrooms but on alternative days.

**This means -**

**Rooms 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 15 & 17 will attend on  
Mondays and Wednesdays**

**Rooms 2, 4, 6, 10, 12, 14, 16 & 18 will attend on  
Tuesdays and Thursdays**

**On the days in between and Fridays work will continue  
from home online.**

This allows for different play and lunch times, and different toilets for each classroom.

Lunches will be provided but the drinking fountains are closed so please send a water bottle.

The children of essential workers will continue to come each day with one day with their class and the others in the bubble they have been working in for the last three weeks.

All staff have been vaccinated and have had a negative Covid test.

We will wear masks.

To keep us safe we need your help: please do not come into school but drop your children at the front gate only, after 8:30am and pick up promptly at 3:00pm. There are road works on Norval Road they will work with us to make access easy.

If you have not yet filled in the survey to let us know if your child/ren are returning we need you to please do this so we know the numbers in each class.
